## Grading rubric

Letter grade	Points out of 10	Description
A+	10	Excellent read, makes insightful comments on connection between the article, stat310 and statistics in practice. Well written with no spelling or grammatical errors.
A	9	Article summarised in no more than a few sentences. Interesting and thoughtful comments, but a few spelling or grammatical errors, or overall flow lacking.
B	8	Too much emphasis on summarising the article, and too little on your response to it and how it connects ideas from stat310 to real life problems.
C	6	Failed to answer all three questions (why did you choose the article? what did you learn and how does it connect to stat310? what question were you left with?)
F	2	Significantly too short: margins too big, font too large, double-spaced etc.
